To apply to the online Master of Legal Studies program at William & Mary Law School, please review the eligibility and application requirements detailed in this document.

ONLINE MLS PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must have completed a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited domestic or foreign institution
- An overall grade point average of 3.0 or greater on a 4.0 scale is expected; applicants with lower GPAs are eligible for admission under exceptional circumstances. Greater weight will be given to the GPA of the last 60 credit hours earned
- At least six months prior work experience in the applicable field of concentration

REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS

To complete your application, you must provide:

- Completed application form
- Official transcript(s)
- Resume/CV
- Personal statement
- Two letters of recommendation from professional or academic recommenders
- Application fee
